

Ephesians chapter 2 questions

Read through the entire Book of Ephesians. (Perhaps use a different translation).

As you read and begin your study, pray and implore the Holy Spirit to speak to you as you study. Be sure to ask, "What does it say about God/Jesus/the Holy Spirit in these verses?". "What has He done?". "What pleases Him?". List some of these.

- 1). What is the main idea of v.1-10? Sum up the central teaching and contrast v.1-3 with v.4-10.
- 2). Why has God saved us from the consequences of our sin? (see v.4, 7). Why are the words "But...God" so sweet (v.4)?
- 3). Why can no one boast or brag about his/her salvation (v.8-9)? Why should it humble us?
- 4). What were we created to do as believers? What is our nature and purpose according to v.10?
- 5). How does it affect you to "remember" your situation before you knew Christ (v.11-12)? How are you encouraged by meditating on your new status (v.13, 19-22)?
- 6). Sum up the main teaching of v.11-22.
- 7). How should this passage change the way you think about the church (v.11-22)? Why is a unified church a great witness to the world?
- 8). Explain the work of Christ in this passage (v.11-22). What has Jesus done for us and how has that changed our identity in Him?

Using the acronym SPECK to aid in applying what you've studied in this chapter, answer the following: What Sin am I being taught to avoid? What Promise do I need to claim? What Example should I follow? What Command do I need to keep? How has this chapter increased my Knowledge of God?
