## Tacana Church Building FAQ May 2022

- What is being proposed? The church is being asked to commit funding of up to \$135,000 for a church building in Tacana. Unsolicited, \$91,000 has already been received for this project. Iglesia del Refugio has committed to 10% of the cost and PIB Indiantown, FL will participate as well.
- 2. What type of building materials will be used? The building will be a concrete block structure as is typical in that setting.
- **3. Will Beech Haven send a team to build the church?** No. Iglesia del Refugio will use a general contractor. The work will be supervised by Pastor Alejandro and Pastor Juan Carillo in coordination with our missions partner, E3 Volunteers, who will handle all the finances.
- How many will the church accommodate? How big is the church? The church and will accommodate 200-300 people and will be approximately 40 x 80 ft<sup>2</sup>.
- **5.** Are there other phases of construction? Yes. Later phases include a Fellowship Hall, kitchen, and parsonage. When those phases are ready to be built, they will be brought to the church in the future for separate consideration.
- **6. Who will own the building?** The building, like the land, will be owned by the Guatemala Baptist Convention.
- 7. How much more money is needed? Will there be a campaign? \$91,000 is on hand. The church needs to be prepared to allocate an additional \$44,000 from designated giving or reserves at the discretion of the Stewardship Committee. The Stewardship Committee believes that God will supply the needs for this project through the people of Beech Haven without a campaign.
- 8. When will construction start and how long will construction take? As soon as funding is committed (as presented in the recommendation), Iglesia del Refugio will receive bids from general contractors and begin the work as soon as weather permits and the building permits from the local government are secured.
